BICYCLE STANDS - VARIOUS LOCATIONS



OVERVIEW

As part of FCC's Active Travel initiative, this project involved the installation of bicycle stands for public use, at various locations in Fingal Co Dublin. This included Balbriggan, Ballyboughal, Donabate, Garristown, Lusk, Oldtown, Portrane, Rush, Skerries, and public park lands.



This project involved installing bicycle stands in high travel areas to encourage more people to use bicycles as a mode of transport in everyday life. Depending on availability of sufficient space, between 3-5 stands are installed. Some are bolted down on existing surfaces, while others require a concrete plinth to be installed, approximately 5m x 2m x 0.2m. All stands are bolted down using safety rawl bolts to prevent hazards. Bollards and signage are installed where required. All plinths are re-instated to match its surrounding, (tar or topsoil and seeded grass).
